Housing Resources

- One to two mentors live next to three to four youth in a duplex.
- Youth sign leases to foster ownership and pay \$300 per month for rent.
- Day to day interactions with mentors and housemates and weekly house dinners.
- Establishment of traditions for birthday celebrations and holidays.
- Secure reliable transportation.

What We Know

On any given night, over **200 youth** are sleeping outside or in emergency shelters, which is the highest number we have seen in our community. This number doesn't fully encapsulate the actual problem. It does not include those couch surfing, moving from place to place, or those fleeing neglect and abuse.

Who We See

600 Unique Youth in our Drop-In Center annually



Capacity to house 35 youth



79 Youth housed over the years

Concerning Data

Of youth we see, there is an over-representation of those who are People of Color (78%) and yet BIPOC only make up 40% of Grand Rapids' population.

Similarly, Youth who are LGBTQ+ represent 37% of the youth we see and yet represent only ~6% of the general population.

Action Steps and Milestones

While we love celebrating the big milestones - job placement, secured housing, reliable transportation - we also celebrate the baby steps to get there. When facing systemic oppression, lack of familial support, past or ongoing trauma - these small action steps are just as worthy of acknowledgment.
